The State of Iowa to the Sheriff of said County, Greeting:

Whereas, at a term of the District Court in and for said County, began and held at the Court House in the City of Iowa City in said County, on the 5th day of April, A. D. 1964, and on the 18th day of September, 1964 thereof, County Attorney's Information was filed in this court, charging Robert Lee Washington with the crime of Murder and on the 30th day of October, 1964, said Robert Lee Washington entered his written plea of guilty to the crime of Murder as charged in said Information, and on the 30th day of October, 1964, said Robert Lee Washington was sentenced to be confined in the State Penitentiary in said State, for the term of not exceeding Sixty (60) years from date of sentence, at hard labor, as appears to us of record Section 690.3 of the 1962 Code of Iowa

WE THEREFORE COMMAND YOU, that you take the body of the said Robert Lee Washington now confined in the jail of said County, and convey him to the State Penitentiary at Fort Madison, Iowa in said State, therein to be confined in accordance with the sentence aforesaid; and we also command the Warden of the State Penitentiary at Fort Madison, Iowa aforesaid to receive the body of the said Robert Lee Washington and him confine in the said State Penitentiary for the term of not exceeding Sixty (60) years at hard labor, and for so doing this shall be his sufficient warrant.

Appeal Bond fixed at Thirty-Thousand (\$30,000.00) - - - Dollars.
